NSRM NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH UPDATE

The NSRM Neighborhood Watch worked with the Ridgely Manor HOA, the Belmeade Condominium Association, and District 9 city councilman Joash Schulman to have a speed study conducted on Ridgely Manor Blvd the week of October 21. The results of the study, conducted by the city's Traffic Engineering office, are expected to be provided by mid-November.

A mobile speed reader trailer positioned on Ridgely Manor Blvd. on October 25 (see photo on right) was in place for two weeks, one week in each direction. The trailer was then placed on Lambeth Lane for an additional week.

These actions are being taken to help quantify vehicle speed and encourage responsible driving in the community.



Speed Limit is 25 mph. Please slow down!!!



Walkers and mothers with children are complaining that cars are speeding in our neighborhood. Please slow down.

Please do not put trash cans, yard waste, or recycle bins in front of mailboxes, trees, or light poles. It may prevent your trash pickup or mail delivery.



Trash Collection

Put yard waste and trash cans where they are not visible from the street until it is time to put them at the curb on Tuesdays in preparation for the VA Beach City trash pickup. Nothing but vehicles should be on the driveways.

Trash Collection is on Wednesday mornings unless Virginia Beach City states otherwise, such as for holidays.

Recycle bins are collected every other Wednesday. If you have forgotten when the recycle trash is to be collected, go to this link:

https://pw.virginiabeach.gov/trash-recycling/recycling-information and enter your address where you see "My Trash Day" on the left side of the page and click the mouse. The collection day will be displayed.

Curbside bulk/large item pick-up is scheduled by request and collected by City-employed operators in City vehicles, usually on the same day as the trash collection. Call 757-385-4640 to schedule a pickup..

Pecan Pie

My husband makes this recipe every year - it is sure to be a winner for your holiday!!!

Ingredients

- 8" frozen pie shell
- 1/2 cup butter
- 1/4 cup unsweetened applesauce)
- 1/2 cup flour
- 1 Vanilla bean (ground fine) or 1 1/2 Teaspoon powdered vanilla
- 1/2 cup hot water
- 1/2 cup maple syrup
- 1 1/3 cup sugar
- 1-5 oz. can evaporated milk
- 1 1/4 to 1 1/2 cup coarsely chopped Green Valley brand Pecan halves
- 1/8 tsp salt

Directions

- 1. Recommend Mrs. Smith's frozen pie shell
- 2. Melt the butter and mix the flour thoroughly with it in a double boiler. This will prevent the flour from lumping. Add vanilla and follow with salt, maple syrup, hot water and sugar.
- 3. When the batter is smooth, mix in evaporated milk and the pecans, and then immediately pour the batter into the pie shell
- Bake at 350° for 50-60 minutes, or until a knife inserted 1 inch from the edge comes out clean.
- 5. Enjoy!!!
